Spirituality of Franciscan Sanctuaries

After traveling with pilgrims for more than twenty years to Franciscan holy places throughout the world—Italy, Prague, England, France, Germany, the Holy Land and the California Missions—this module will offer to guide prospective pilgrims to places that are made holy by the people who lived there and the events that happened to there. This module will begin with a consideration of the concept of *pilgrimage* and the *sacred place* based on the *spirituality* of the events that occurred at these holy places. All of this will be considered through the prism of the sanctuaries in Franciscan Italy. Through power-point photos and lecture, each session will look at one or more Franciscan sanctuary in the light of the history and spirituality connected with these sacred places.
